

Monitoring Violation Notice

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for Winkler WSC-TX1750023

Our system failed to collect the required coliform sample for the month of March 2025. Although this incident was not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did (are doing) to correct this situation.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During March 1, 2025-March 31, 2025, we did not monitor the monthly samples for coliform bacteria and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time. You may continue to drink the water. If a situation arises where the water is no longer safe to drink, we are required to notify you within 24 hours.

What is being done?

We will be doing the sampling each month from here on out to verify that the water you consume meets health standards.

There was a "special" sample that was taken in mid-March due to low pressure and the sample was satisfactory.
